## REQUIREMENTS:

1. Submit an application AND email your resume or explanation of qualifications including work or volunteer history AND 1-2 sentences describing your interest in becoming a fair housing tester
2. Attend a fair housing tester training
3. Complete a practice fair housing test

## QUALIFICATIONS:

- Computer access from home
- Willingness to learn Adobe Acrobat
- Comfort with speaking on the phone
- Strong writing skills & attention to detail
- Ability to follow complex instructions
- Currently reside within MFHC's service area (Hampden, Hampshire, Franklin, Berkshire and Worcester counties)
- Do not currently or within the past year work as a real estate agent, broker, property manager, landlord or other housing provider
