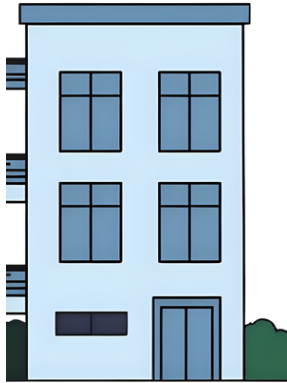


WHO DO I CALL ABOUT LEAD?



I'm worried my apartment has lead. Who do I call?



Reach out to your local Board of Health/Inspectional Services Department to request a lead inspection.

If they do not have lead inspector, contact **CLPPP** at (800) 532-9571 or (617) 624-5757

I'm applying for an apartment and the housing provider told me it doesn't have a lead certificate so they can't rent to my family. Who do I call?



Contact your local fair housing agency, **the Massachusetts Commission Against Discrimination** (MCAD) (413) 739-2145, your local housing court, or local bar association

I have a child under 6 and learned there's lead paint in my apartment. Now my landlord is telling me to move out. Who do I call?

Contact your local fair housing agency, **MCAD**, your local housing court, or local bar association.
